RE: Subdistrict No. 6 Replacement Water Accounting for the Month of April 2026

Dear Mr. Cotten,

The following Tables 1, 2, and 3 illustrate Subdistrict No. 6's accounting of its daily replacement operations for the month of April 2026 as required in Term and Condition No. 7 of the State Engineer's 2025 Annual Replacement Plan Approval Letter received on May 1, 2025. The tables include data regarding the following: daily and monthly Subdistrict No. 6 projected stream depletion obligations; replacement/remedy sources used; daily and monthly amount of each replacement/remedy source used; and, identification of the water rights that received replacement/remedy from the Subdistrict on a daily basis.

Synopsis of April 2026 Subdistrict No. 6 Replacement Operations

Under the direction of the Division No. 3 Division Engineer and District 20, 21, and 22 Water Commissioners, Subdistrict No. 6 replaced all projected injurious stream reach depletions on the Rio Grande, Alamosa River, and Conejos River on a daily basis for the month of April 2026 pursuant to the projected amounts calculated in Table 2.3 included in the approved 2025 Preliminary Water Report ("PWR") letter received on March 25, 2026. Replacement of injurious stream depletions began on May 1, 2025 on the Rio Grande, the Alamosa River, and the Conejos River.

Replacement Operations on the Rio Grande

For the month of April 2026, Subdistrict No. 6 used 24.6 acre-feet of stored BLM Shaw Reservoir water to remedy the Subdistrict's depletions from January through March which the Closed Basin Project production did not cover and 10.87 acre-feet of stored water associated with Los Sauces SWSP ID# 9528 to remedy depletions identified in the Subdistrict's 2025 PWR to make replacements to all injured water rights on the Rio Grande which did not have an approved Forbearance Agreement in place with the Subdistrict. The Subdistrict also used 304.33 acre-feet of forbearance in the month of April 2026. The following Table 1 illustrates the Subdistrict's daily replacement operations for the Rio Grande during the month of April 2026.

Per SWSP ID# 9377, Table 1 illustrates all days during the month of April 2026 in which Monte Vista Canal ATM/SWSP water was used to replace depletions on the Rio Grande caused by Subdistrict No. 6 wells. The total amount of water used to cover injurious stream depletions and associated transit loss on the Rio Grande during the month of April 2026 was 0.0 ac-ft.

Per SWSP ID# 6074 and 6093, Table 1 illustrates all days during the month of April 2026 in which the Taos Valley No. 3 water rights was used to replace depletions caused by Subdistrict No. 6 wells. The total amount used to remedy injurious stream depletions and associated transit losses on the Rio Grande during the month of April 2026 was 0.0 ac-ft.

Per SWSP ID# 6182, Table 1 illustrates all days during the month of April 2026 in which leased Williams Creek Squaw Pass Transmountain water rights was used to replace depletions caused by Subdistrict No. 6 wells. The total amount used to cover injurious stream depletions and associated transit losses on the

Rio Grande during the month of April 2026 was 0.0 ac-ft.

Per SWSP ID# 7265, Table 1 illustrates all days during the month of April 2026 in which CPW Tabor Ditch No. 2 water rights was used to replace depletions caused by Subdistrict No. 6 wells. The total amount used to cover injurious stream depletions and associated transit losses on the Rio Grande during the month of April 2026 was 0.0 ac-ft.

Per SWSP ID# 9528, Table 1 illustrates all days during the month of April 2026 in which Los Sauces Ditch water and/or Depletion Bank Credits were used to replace depletions caused by Subdistrict No. 6 wells. The total amount used to cover injurious stream depletions and associated transit losses on the Rio Grande during the month of April 2026 was 10.87 ac-ft.

Per SWSP ID# 9438, Table 1 illustrates all days during the month of April 2026 in which BLM's Shaw Reservoir water was used to replace depletions caused by Subdistrict No. 6 wells. The total amount used to cover injurious stream depletions and associated transit losses on the Rio Grande during the month of April 2026 was 24.6 ac-ft.

Replacement Operations on the Conejos River

For the month of April 2026, Subdistrict No. 6 used 17.42 acre-feet of Depletion Bank Credits associated with Los Sauces SWSP ID# 9528 to remedy the Subdistrict's depletions from January through March which the Closed Basin Project production did not cover and 99.94 acre-feet of stored water associated with SWSP ID# 6182 to make replacements to all injured water rights on the Conejos River which did not have an approved Forbearance Agreement in place with the Subdistrict. The Subdistrict also used 101.26 acre-feet of forbearance in the month of April 2026. The following Table 2 illustrates the Subdistrict's daily replacement operations for the Conejos during the month of April 2026.

Per SWSP ID# 6182, Table 2 illustrates all days during the month of April 2026 in which leased San Luis Valley Water Conservancy District water rights was used to replace depletions caused by Subdistrict No. 6 wells. The total amount used to cover injurious stream depletions and associated transit losses on the Conejos River during the month of April 2026 was 99.94 ac-ft.

Per SWSP ID# 6163, Table 2 illustrates all days during the month of April 2026 in which leased BLM Lovato Ditch Augmentation water right was used to replace depletions caused by Subdistrict No. 6 wells. The total amount used to cover injurious stream depletions and associated transit losses on the Conejos River during the month of April 2026 was 0.0 ac-ft.

Per SWSP ID# 6074 and 6093, Table 2 illustrates all days during the month of April 2026 in which the Taos Valley No. 3 water right was used to replace depletions caused by Subdistrict No. 6 wells. The total amount used to cover injurious stream depletions and associated transit losses on the Conejos during the month of April 2026 was 0.0 ac-ft.

Per SWSP ID# 9528, Table 2 illustrates all days during the month of April 2026 in which Los Sauces Ditch water and/or Depletion Bank Credits were used to replace depletions caused by Subdistrict No. 6 wells. The total amount used to cover injurious stream depletions and associated transit losses on the Conejos River during the month of April 2026 was 17.42 ac-ft.

Replacement Operations on the Alamosa River

For the month of April 2026, Subdistrict No. 6 used 11.75 acre-feet to remedy depletions identified in the Subdistrict's 2025 PWR and to make replacements to all injured water rights on the approved Forbearance Agreements in place with the Subdistrict to make replacements to all injured water rights

on the Alamosa River. The Subdistrict also used 118.99 acre-feet of forbearance in the month of April 2026. The following Table 3 illustrates the Subdistrict's daily replacement operations for the Alamosa during the month of April 2026.

Per SWSP ID# 6209, Table 3 illustrates all days during the month of April 2026 in which Terrace Irrigation Company's Excess Augmentation Credits were used to replace depletions on the Alamosa River caused by Subdistrict No. 6 wells. The total amount of water used to cover injurious stream depletions on the Alamosa River during April 2026 was 0.0 ac-ft.

Per SWSP ID# 9377, Table 3 illustrates all days during the month of April 2026 in which Monte Vista Canal ATM/SWSP water was used to replace depletions on the Alamosa River caused by Subdistrict No. 6 wells. The total amount of water used to cover injurious stream depletions on the Alamosa River during April 2026 was 11.75 ac-ft.

Per SWSP ID# 9441, Table 3 illustrates all days during the month of April 2026 in which Reinhardt Leased water was used to replace depletions on the Alamosa River caused by Subdistrict No. 6 wells. The total amount of water used to cover injurious stream depletions on the Alamosa River during April 2026 was 0.0 ac-ft.

Per SWSP ID# 9486, Table 3 illustrates all days during the month of April 2026 in which EXPO, LLC's Excess Augmentation Credits were used to replace depletions on the Alamosa River caused by Subdistrict No. 6 wells. The total amount of water used to cover injurious stream depletions on the Alamosa River during April 2026 was 0.0 ac-ft.
