Approval of the Agenda

Discussion on Contracting to Remedy Depletions from a Saguache Response Area Well
President Frees asked for discussion on contracting to remedy depletions from a Saguache
response area well. Chris Ivers gave an update on Well Injury Payment agreements and was
given direction to reach out to those who have not responded. Discussion was held on the need
of a replacement source of water to be delivered to the stream and where that source could
potentially come from. President Frees asked for guidance from the Division of Water
Resources regarding the amount of acre feet needed to satisfy the injured junior surface water
rights. President Frees suggested a fallow contract be negotiated with the Freel Ranch and how
the Bowman property could be of a benefit to the Subdistrict. Clinton Phillips provided the
pumping records for both properties. Discussion was held on possibly leasing land and the
potential costs associated with running a pump. Chris Ivers was provided with direction to make
a counter offer to Mr. Bowman, the amount was discussed.

Tim Lobato addressed the Board and expressed his interest in contracting into Subdistrict No. 4. Mr. Lobato reported also being in Subdistrict No. 5 and is in the process of preparing his own augmentation plan. He provided his average annual depletions to the San Luis Creek and explained how he is handling his depletions to the Saguache Creek in Subdistrict No. 5. Discussion was held on how his depletions would be remedied in Subdistrict No. 4.

New Business

President Frees asked for new business. Chris Schaefer provided an update on the Fish and Wildlife Service contract. He reported on how they are planning on operating Well Injury Payment agreements. Pete Ampe clarified how it would work with the other Subdistricts.
