#### Meeting Called to Order

President Schmittel called the meeting to order at 3:07 p.m. A quorum was present for the meeting.

#### Approval of the Agenda

President Schmittel asked for any changes, additions or a motion to approve the agenda. A motion was made by Kit Caldon to approve the agenda as presented. The motion was seconded by Dale Gerstberger and unanimously approved.

#### **Public Comment**

President Schmittel asked for public comment. Willie Hoffner asked about the events that lead to the Subdistrict shut down last year. Chris Ivers explained the judicial review and where it could be found in the Groundwater Rules.

### **Executive Session**

# Approval of the 2022 Annual Replacement Plan

Discussion was held on the groundwater allocation and when it would take effect. Pete Ampe explained why the Subdistrict would be asking for a variance rather than submitting an incomplete ARP. Willie Hoffner asked the Board of Managers if they were aware of the letter from the Saguache County Commissioners to Kevin Rein and if there was any ground in Subdistrict No. 5 outside of Saguache County. Dale Gerstberger highlighted the reduction in pumping last year.

A motion was made by Kit Caldon to file a one-week extension of the ARP deadline. The motion was seconded by Dale Gerstberger and unanimously approved.

President Schmittel asked for other director reports/comments/questions. Discussion was held on when the Subdistrict would be able to pump and if they were working on options in order to get the ARP approved.
