RE: Subdistrict No. 6 Replacement Water Accounting for the Month of May 2026

Dear Mr. Cotten,

The following Tables 1 through 4 illustrate Subdistrict No. 6's accounting of its daily replacement operations for the month of May 2026 as required in Term and Condition No. 7 of the State Engineer's 2026 Annual Replacement Plan Approval Letter received on May 1, 2026. The tables include data regarding the following: daily and monthly Subdistrict No. 6 projected stream depletion obligations; replacement/remedy sources used; daily and monthly amount of each replacement/remedy source used; and, identification of the water rights that received replacement/remedy from the Subdistrict on a daily basis.

Synopsis of May 2026 Subdistrict No. 6 Replacement Operations

Under the direction of the Division No. 3 Division Engineer and District 20, 21, and 22 Water Commissioners, Subdistrict No. 6 replaced all projected injurious stream reach depletions on the Rio Grande, Alamosa River, La Jara Creek and Conejos River on a daily basis for the month of May 2026 pursuant to the projected amounts calculated in Table 2.3 included in the approved 2026 Annual Replacement Plan letter from DWR. Replacement of injurious stream depletions began on May 1, 2026 on the Rio Grande, the Alamosa River, La Jara Creek and the Conejos River.

Replacement Operations on the Rio Grande

For the month of May 2026, Subdistrict No. 6 used 31.99 ac-ft. of stored Santa Maria Reservoir Company water leased from Subdistrict No. 1, 29.15 ac-ft. of Los Sauces "Native" water, and 2.78 ac-ft. of stored Shaw Reservoir water, for a total of 63.91 ac-ft., to make replacements to all injured water rights on the Rio Grande which did not have an approved Forbearance Agreement in place with the Subdistrict. Approved Forbearance Agreements covered 309.65 ac-ft. of depletions during the month of May 2026. The following Table 1 illustrates the Subdistrict's daily replacement operations for the Rio Grande during the month of May 2026.

Per SWSP ID 9438, Table 1 illustrates all days during the month of May 2026 in which Shaw Reservoir water was used to replace depletions on the Rio Grande caused by Subdistrict No. 6 wells. The total amount of water used to cover injurious stream depletions on the Rio Grande during the month of May 2026 was 2.78 ac-ft.

Per SWSP ID 9528, Table 1 illustrates all days during the month of May 2026 in which Los Sauces water was used to replace depletions on the Rio Grande caused by Subdistrict No. 6 wells. The total amount of water used to cover injurious stream depletions on the Rio Grande during the month of May 2026 was 29.15 ac-ft.

Per SWSP ID 9377, Table 1 illustrates all days during the month of May 2026 in which Monte Vista Canal ATM/SWSP water was used to replace depletions on the Rio Grande caused by Subdistrict No. 6 wells. The total amount of water used to cover injurious stream depletions on the Rio Grande during the month of May 2026 was 0.0 ac-ft.

Per SWSP ID 6074, Table 1 illustrates all days during the month of May 2026 in which the Taos Valley No. 3 water rights was used to replace depletions caused by Subdistrict No. 6 wells. The total amount used to remedy injurious stream depletions on the Rio Grande during the month of May 2026 was 0.0 ac-ft.

Per SWSP ID 6182, Table 1 illustrates all days during the month of May 2026 in which leased Williams Creek Squaw Pass Transmountain water rights was used to replace depletions caused by Subdistrict No. 6 wells. The total amount used to cover injurious stream depletions on the Rio Grande during the month of May 2026 was 0.0 ac-ft.

Per SWSP ID 7265, Table 1 illustrates all days during the month of May 2026 in which CPW Tabor Ditch No. 2 water rights were used to replace depletions caused by Subdistrict No. 6 wells. The total amount used to cover injurious stream depletions on the Rio Grande during the month of May 2026 was 0.0 ac-ft.

Replacement Operations on the Conejos River

For the month of May 2026, Subdistrict No. 6 used 57.40 ac-ft. stored BLM Lovato Ditch water and 36.18 ac-ft. of leased San Luis Valley Water Conservancy District water rights, for a total of 93.58 ac-ft., to make replacements to all injured water rights on the Conejos which did not have an approved Forbearance Agreement in place with the Subdistrict. Approved Forbearance Agreements covered 247.71 ac-ft. of depletions during the month of May 2026. The following Table 2 illustrates the Subdistrict's daily replacement operations for the Conejos during the month of May 2026.

Per SWSP ID 6182, Table 2 illustrates all days during the month of May 2026 in which leased San Luis Valley Water Conservancy District water rights was used to replace depletions caused by Subdistrict No. 6 wells. The total amount used to cover injurious stream depletions on the Conejos River during the month of May 2026 was 36.18 ac-ft.

Per SWSP ID 6163, Table 2 illustrates all days during the month of May 2026 in which leased BLM Lovato Ditch Augmentation water rights was used to replace depletions caused by Subdistrict No. 6 wells. The total amount used to cover injurious stream depletions on the Conejos River during the month of May 2026 was 57.40 ac-ft.

Per SWSP ID 6074, Table 2 illustrates all days during the month of May 2026 in which the Taos Valley No. 3 water rights was used to replace depletions caused by Subdistrict No. 6 wells. The total amount used to cover injurious stream depletions on the Conejos during the month of May 2026 was 0.0 ac-ft.

Per SWSP ID 9528, Table 1 illustrates all days during the month of May 2026 in which Los Sauces water was used to replace depletions caused by Subdistrict No. 6 wells. The total amount of water used to cover injurious stream depletions on the Rio Grande during the month of May 2026 was 0.0 ac-ft.

Replacement Operations on the Alamosa River

For the month of May 2026, Subdistrict No. 6 used 2.80 ac-ft. stored Monte Vista Canal ATM/SWSP water to make replacements to all injured water rights on the Alamosa River which did not have an approved Forbearance Agreement in place with the Subdistrict. Approved Forbearance Agreements covered 89.37 ac-ft. of depletions during the month of May 2026. The following Table 3 illustrates the Subdistrict's daily replacement operations for the Alamosa River during the month of May 2026.

Per SWSP ID 6209, Table 3 illustrates all days during the month of May 2026 in which Terrace Irrigation Company's Excess Augmentation Credits were used to replace depletions on the Alamosa River caused

by Subdistrict No. 6 wells. The total amount of water used to cover injurious stream depletions on the Alamosa River during May 2026 was 0.0 ac-ft.

Per SWSP ID 9377, Table 3 illustrates all days during the month of May 2026 in which Monte Vista Canal ATM/SWSP water was used to replace depletions on the Alamosa River caused by Subdistrict No. 6 wells. The total amount of water used to cover injurious stream depletions on the Alamosa River during May 2026 was 2.80 ac-ft.

Per SWSP ID 9441, Table 3 illustrates all days during the month of May 2026 in which Reinhardt Leased water was used to replace depletions on the Alamosa River caused by Subdistrict No. 6 wells. The total amount of water used to cover injurious stream depletions on the Alamosa River during May 2026 was 0.0 ac-ft.

Replacement Operations on La Jara Creek

For the month of May 2026, Subdistrict No. 6 would have used an approved Forbearance Agreement in place with the Subdistrict to make replacements to all injured water rights on La Jara Creek but was not required to do so because of Subdistrict accretions to the La Jara Creek. The following Table 4 illustrates the Subdistrict's daily replacement operations for the Alamosa during the month of May 2026.
